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SOCIETY INFORMATION SHEET

Please complete all details on the reservation form.

If we have provisionally booked your event over the telephone, we will hold this for you for one month. A deposit of £100.00 is payable to secure your booking and should accompany your reservation form

All Green Fees must be paid to the Club Professional before play commences

All matches are to play from the Yellow Markers (or Red if Ladies)

All catering requirements are to be confirmed to the Head Chef at least one week prior to the arranged date. The Head Chef can be contacted on 0116 239 3457 (Option 5).

The Organiser is responsible for ensuring that ALL Society Members observe the Rules of Golf, Course Etiquette, Club Local Rules and Standards of Dress. Standards of dress can be found below:

ON THE COURSE

Members, their guests and visitors who fail to observe the Dress Code will not be allowed access to the golf course.

GENTLEMEN

Shoes - Shoes designed for golf must be worn. The wearing of soft spikes or dimple golf shoes is obligatory from 1st April until 31st October. This restriction may be amended by the Council in extreme weather conditions.

Trousers, shirts and socks - Tailored shorts (not below the knee) are to be worn with either knee length socks or white sports socks that are visible. **NOT PERMITTED** - Sports, beach, boxer or swimming shorts. Long trousers with external pockets/combat style. Mid-calf, cargo/combat style shorts or shorts with external pockets. Socks that are not visible above the shoe.

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Shirts - Shirts must be tucked into the waistband of the trouser or shorts at all times. The new style "turtle neck" shirts are permitted. **NOT PERMITTED** - Collarless or sleeveless shirts (unless they are shirts specifically designed for the playing of golf) or shirts worn as such, printed t- shirts, football/rugby style shirts.

Head Gear - Baseball caps may be worn but with the peak at the front (not turned up)

General - The wearing of denim clothing and jeans, tracksuit or shell suits is not permitted.

LADIES

Shoes - Shoes designed for golf must be worn. The wearing of soft spikes or dimple golf shoes is obligatory from 1st April until 31st October. This restriction may be amended by the Council in extreme weather conditions.

Shorts - Tailored shorts.

Shirts - Sleeveless shirts are permitted. Collarless shirts are not permitted (unless they are shirts specifically designed for the playing of golf).

In any query regarding the Dress Code on the Course, the Professional is the final arbiter.

IN THE CLUBHOUSE

Member(s), their guest(s) and visitors who fail to observe the Dress Code will not be served at the Bar or in the Dining Room and will be asked to leave the Clubhouse.

General - Clean, smart casual dress. Caps or hats must not be worn. Damp or soiled golfing attire is not considered appropriate outside of the Changing Rooms. Gentlemen's tailored shorts (not below the knee) may be worn. Shoes or sandals must be worn at all times – Trainers and flip flops are not allowed.

Shirts (Not permitted - Printed T-shirts, football or rugby style shirts, tracksuits, shell suits, sleeveless or collarless shirts (unless they are shirts specifically designed for the playing of golf).

Shorts (Not permitted) - Sports, Beach, Boxer or swimming shorts. Mid calf, cargo/combat style shorts with external pockets

THE DINING ROOM

After 7.00pm during the week and at all times on Saturdays and Sundays golfers are required to change out of the clothes in which they have played golf prior to entering the Dining Room.

SOCIETY AND TEAM MATCHES

When using the Dining Room in the evening, all members of Societies or Teams must wear jacket and tie. (Removal of Jackets in the Dining Room, on these occasions, will be at the discretion of the Captain or any other Authorised person)

In any query regarding the Dress Code in the Clubhouse, a Council member or the Bar Manager is the final arbiter.

PACKAGES & RATES

Golf packages are available for societies at the following competitive rates:

Societies of 8 or more

To 31st March and then 1st October onwards

- 18 hole package £25.00 weekday per person includes bacon roll and tea/coffee or Basket Meal. Weekends £30.00

1st April - 30th September

- 18 hole package £42.00 weekday includes bacon roll and 2 course meal. Weekends £47.00
- 27 hole package £52.00 weekday includes bacon roll, light lunch and 2 course meal.
- 36 hole package £60.00 weekday includes bacon roll, light lunch and 2 course evening meal.
